Horizon Lines Hires Waypoint Solutions Group For Managed Messaging in U.S., Guam, Puerto Rico

CHARLOTTE, N.C., June 01, 2006 — Horizon Lines — the nation's leading domestic ocean container shipping and logistics company, providing cargo transportation services between the continental U.S. and Alaska, Hawaii, Guam and Puerto Rico — has signed a three-year agreement engaging Charlotte-based Waypoint Solutions Group to provide Managed Messaging Services to Horizon's server locations in 7 U.S. states, Guam and Puerto Rico. Financial terms of the deal were not disclosed.

Horizon Lines' global messaging environment supports more than 1000 users and includes more than 16 messaging servers (Microsoft Exchange), front-end Internet gateways, and a Blackberry Enterprise server.

Waypoint will manage the Horizon Lines messaging server network that connects its personnel in Dallas, Texas; Charlotte, N.C.; Elizabeth, N.J.; Long Beach and Oakland,
